- Progress report on use of Sustainable Schools \$14k grant. Site specific report completed with triangle between driveway, road and #41 Elanora Road identified as greatest impact.
- Contractor Dragonfly to regenerate with potential low intensity spot burns and remove young white spot gums.
- Parent engagement required for work along drive and bank below cave to be restored. Possibility of a bush regenerator working with groups of volunteers to provide guidance and supervision. Call for volunteers to go out in Newsletter.
