- Student reports will be emailed out in week 10.
- 4 of our ensembles; String Beans, Mezzo Strings, Senior Strings and Senior Band performed at the NSWEE Festival at Pittwater High School and Cromer High School. Newly formed parent committee is prioritising fundraising with busking at the park and a Bunnings BBQ being organised.
- Week 6 Wellbeing week activities being appreciated by Teachers. Students, families and teachers are needing wellbeing support and opportunities to meet with others and build community
- Weekly Teacher Professional Learning has included Accreditation sessions and NEST (Narrabeen Elanora Student Teachers Collaboration) professional learning.
- Next week, five Year 5 students will attend "Learn to Fly' HPGE calss at Narrabeen Sports High.
- The executive team is working on completing annual reflections of school improvement plan and annual school report.
- New budget provided at end of May Deputy position put on review with school numbers moving steadily toward cap of 480 students.
- Several maintenance projects lodged with Facilities First have been approved and awaiting project managers. With less contractors available, these jobs are joining a long list. Cooler classrooms is close to finishing stages but with all units working, power issues are occurring – work is underway to rectify. Maintenance projects which have been lodged include:

 - 9. Kitchen in CommOSH
