#### Wednesday 7th April Manly Surf and Slide

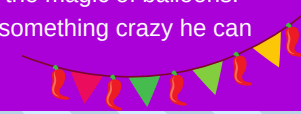

#### Friday 9th of April Crazy Character Day

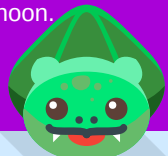

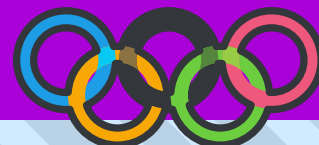
#### Tuesday 13th April Reptile Park Excursion
